**Equipment Pick-Up/Return Policy**

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## **1 EQUIPMENT PICK-UP POLICY:**

SurDel Girls Soccer Club requires that all coaches provide a \$50.00 cheque (post dated for April 15 of the next year and payable to SurDel Girls Soccer Club) upon pick-up of your equipment.

Note that under no circumstances will equipment be issued without your \$50.00 equipment deposit. This includes soccer balls.

- Remind parents to hang their uniforms to dry. It extends the life of the uniform. Purchasing new uniforms costs money, which in turn results in higher registration fees.
- Remind parents that they are allowed to remove the liners from the shorts. However, please inform the parents that at least 2-3” of the liner must remain to prevent shredding of the shorts.
- Refrain from dragging the soccer ball bags on the ground. The soccer ball bags must be carried off the ground.
- If the new practice and game soccer balls go flat, please return the ball(s) to the Equipment Manager so that they can be exchanged with our supplier. This saves the Club money on not having to purchase new replacement balls.
- Please take good care of the net bag kits, as their replacement value is high. Each net bag kit includes 1 large equipment bag, 2 regulation-sized nets (only 1 for Metro and U-21/Womens), a set of 4 corner flags with their own bag, 8 nail pegs, 1 hammer, and twist ties.

## **2 EQUIPMENT RETURN POLICY:**

If your equipment is not returned prior to April 15, then your equipment deposit will be cashed. All equipment must be returned before the start up of the Spring League and then equipment will be resigned out for the Spring League.

Please assist our Equipment Managers by helping them in the following ways:

1. All equipment must be returned on Equipment Return Day except those teams that are in Provincial Playoffs.
2. Ensure you are prompt to pick up and return Uniforms and Equipment
3. Should an alternative day be necessary please be reasonable.
4. Please ensure you return unused uniforms (uniforms that have not been assigned to players).
5. Please mark a large “X” over the inflation hole on balls that are losing air.

6. Please return ALL uniforms CLEAN.

## 2.1 CRITERIA FOR RETURNING EQUIPMENT

- Empty the Rubbermaid bin, wash it, inside and out, with hot soapy water.
- Do not return items that do not belong to the club (e.g. water bottles, hair ties, clothes, etc.)
- Hose down all the balls and the ball bag and return them dry and clean.
- Launder all keeper jerseys, pinnies, etc. yourself before returning. **WASH THEM YOURSELF DO NOT RETURN DIRTY/DAMP ITEMS.**
- Ensure that your players' parents launder their jerseys and shorts. They may keep the socks and please do not leave them in plastic bags inside the Rubbermaid totes. **WE HAVE TO THEN RIP OPEN EVERY BAG AND THIS IS A WASTE OF OUR TIME.**

**RETURNING DIRTY BINS, EXTRANEIOUS ITEMS THAT DO NOT BELONG, UNIFORMS IN PLASTIC BAGS, DIRTY BALLS AND BALL BAGS AND UNLAUNDERED CLEAN ITEMS IS UNACCEPTABLE AND COULD RESULT IN YOUR EQUIPMENT DEPOSIT CHEQUE BEING CASHED.**

Please ensure you have attached a list of players, complete with phone numbers who have not returned their uniforms, this will ensure that if necessary we can cash cheques of those who have not returned their uniforms. If you are missing equipment please leave a detailed note in your Rubbermaid tote.

**EQUIPMENT NOT RETURNED WITHIN 15 DAYS OF EQUIPMENT RETURN DAY WILL ALSO RESULT IN THE CASHING OF YOUR EQUIPMENT DEPOSIT.**

Note that the Club will not be penalizing you for missing balls, cones, and wosses.
